- Three current (within the past year) original letters of recommendation from individuals (college professors and administrative superiors) who know your professional work and/or academic work and can address your potential for success in a graduate program. All of the letters must be sent to the Graduate Coordinator within the application package. (There is no required format.)
- Updated résumé / Curriculum Vita
- Official GRE (must include Verbal, Quantitative, and Written scores, and must not be older than two years).
- International applicants: official TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) passing score(s)

- ❗ Applicants may be invited to interviews (group or individual). Interviews may be requested but cannot always be granted.
- ❗ Application materials, besides the GRE scores, that are faxed or e-mailed must be followed-up with the originals.
