COURSE OUTLINE FOR TEACHERS OF VISUALLY IMPAIRED STUDENTS SPECIALIZATION Electives:

4 Elective Courses (10-12 credits) are required and are determined by advisor and student. They must include the following categories:

1. Three (3) credits in Teaching of Reading (if you have no previous course)

<u>Options</u>: SERP 508 Teaching Students with High Incidence Disabilities LRC 505 Essentials of Reading and Writing LRC 507 Teaching of Reading: Decoding and Comprehension Any other course in reading approved by adviser

2. Three (3) credits in working with students who have multiple disabilities

Options: SERP 513 Educating Students with Mental Retardation and Severe Disabilities SERP 515 Foundations of Assessment and Instruction of Learners with Low Incidence Disabilities SERP 518 Augmentative Communication for Learners with Severe and Multiple Disabilities Any other course in multiple disabilities approved by adviser

3. Three (3) credits in assistive technology, with emphasis on visual impairment

SERP 519b Assistive Technology for Students with Visual Impairments Any other course in assistive technology approved by adviser

4. An additional elective from the following list

SERP 505 Foundations of Learning Disabilities SERP 502 Behavior Principles and Disabilities* SERP 519c Advanced Low Vision (Offered every one to two years) SERP 534 Language Development for the Exceptional Child* Any other course in special education or a related field as approved by adviser

Teaching certificate requirements

If you are not certified as a teacher in Arizona, you will be required to:

• Complete two courses in Structured English Immersion. If you take LRC 516 and LRC 517 at The University of Arizona, the first course will count as an elective in your Master's program. You can also take the online SEI courses through UA South (LCEV 508 and 516) to meet this requirement.

- Take an Arizona/U.S. Constitution course within three years of obtaining your initial certificate.
- Take and pass the AEPA Elementary Professional Knowledge exam in Elementary Education (91). If you are earning certification in visual impairment and are not earning a master's degree, you must also take the Special Education Exam in Visually Impaired (32)
