



Gaining Arizona Residency for In-State Tuition

In order to gain Arizona residency at The University of Arizona, out-of-state graduate students need to start the process as soon as they arrive to campus. Students must have established residency one year prior to the semester in which they would like to request classification as an Arizona resident. Here are a few steps you can take to ensure you are able to gain Arizona residency.

Fall Semester

- Establish a year-round Arizona residence
- Get an Arizona driver's license/ID (1 year)
- Register your vehicle, if applicable (1 year)
- Register to vote/cast your ballot in Arizona
 - You can use your Arizona ID to register online at https://voter.azsos.gov/

Spring Semester

- Use Arizona address to file and pay Arizona taxes
- Apply in Summer 2017 for 2017-18 academic year
- Be prepared to submit supporting documents
 - 2 years of bank statements; 2 years of tax returns; copies of other materials listed above
